# Scouts mark their centenary

SCOUTS gathered in St Peter's Hill, Grantham, at 8am on Wednesday for a "sunrise ceremony" to mark the centenary of the movement.

District commissioner Berni Carey sounded a recording of a kudu horn to start the ceremony which was attended by beavers, cubs, scouts, leaders and parents, many of whom had stayed up all night in preparation for the event. Similar events were taking place at 8am around the world, starting in New Zealand.

The ceremony marked the 100th anniversary of the first scout camp run by Robert Baden-Powell on Brownsea Island. Since then the movement has spread around the globe.

Scouts in Whissendine, Leicestershire, were out in the countryside even earlier to witness the sunrise before their own ceremony took place at 8am.

At the ceremony musicians from the Gang Show performed music and the National Anthem was played on the keyboard. Group scout leader Ian Tan

read out a letter written to all Scouts by Baden-Powell before he died. There was also a display of scouting history and memorabilia.
