Be it a couple of hours a week as a leader or helper, or maybe two hours every other month as a committee member or fundraiser - every single bit of support counts.

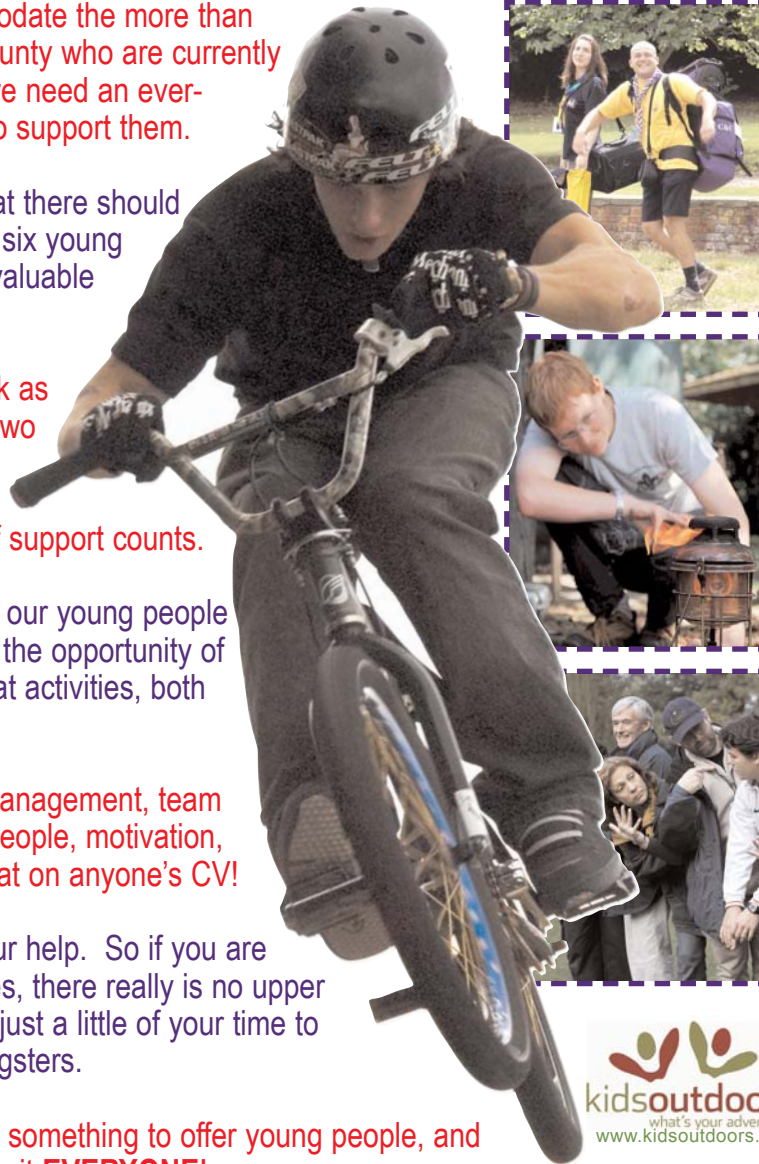
And the benefits are not all to our young people either! Scouting offers adults the opportunity of taking part in some really great activities, both indoors and outdoors.
