A CHARITY has received money raised in memory of a Scout leader.

Lincoln District Scouting lost valued leader Andy Onion in 2007 to bowel cancer.

He had suffered from Crohn's disease from a young age and died shortly after returning from his honeymoon in September 2007.

Members held a disco with sketches from previous Gang Shows which raised

around £600. The money will go to the Crohn's Disease Society.

Mr Onion first joined Lincoln District Scouts as a Cub Scout.

He was a member of the Scout band and a valued member of the Gang Show.
